Workshop on Hydroponic Farming.

It was intended to make the animators aware of the possibilities of farming with less water and space. Mr. Sunil Jose, an expert in hydroponic farming was the recourse person.



Capacity Building Workshop on Organic Farming to The SHG Women in Maradiyur.

Three days of workshop on Organic farming was organized in Auxilium Preethi Nivas Maradiyur, for the members of SHGs. Mr. Kiran Kaariyappa and Mrs. Reema Kaariyappa were the Resource persons of the day. Sr. Rosy, CDEW directress in her inaugural address explained the acute health problems due to the farmers use of chemical fertilisers and pesticides.

Mr. Kiran Kaariyappa, an experienced person in organic farming demonstrated the process of preparing vermi- compost to reduce the expenses of chemical fertilizers and it is pure organic manure and can be used for all the crops.

During session on poultry farming, the resource person explained the varieties of poultry and how the women can start courtyard poultry farming as a source of income. A sapling each was given to all the participants.
